This can be created through painting directly on the storefront window or possibly through a free standing installation within the business window display space. We anticipate most art installations will be directly applied to the storefront windows.

Please provide 2-3 sketches (pencil or digital) showing your idea/concept. Please include a written explanation of your installation to help the judge/board members visualize your idea/concept.

If you plan to paint directly on the window, keep in mind that most businesses still need customers to be able to see through to their display, so painting might need to be done along the frame. Consider a rectangular or square image as most storefront windows are one of those shapes.

If you are proposing an installation in the storefront itself, it will need to be free standing and not attached directly to the walls or ceiling. You can use a variety of materials.
