5.a. SDFC Soccer Celebration	5.a. Curt Brooker reported that the San Diego FC Soccer Celebration will take place tomorrow, Thursday, June 18th, at Memorial Park. The event will feature a viewing of the Mexico vs. South Korea match at 6:00 pm, with additional viewing screens, vendors, and a beer garden. The celebration will conclude with a live concert. A site map of the event’s layout and timetable was provided and discussed. An estimated 10,000 attendees had confirmed to the event on an online portal, estimating double that capacity may be present on Third Avenue. Concerns were expressed regarding unauthorized street vendors and the proposed relocation of some paid vendor booths. The relocation would redirect foot traffic to businesses farther north, which may not benefit as much from activities at Memorial Park. Additionally, potential sound issues were raised concerning the performance scheduled to follow the watch party, again those away from Memorial Park.	<i>5.a. No action taken.</i>
