The cost is 6,000\$ but this covers the decorations which will belong to us, and we can use for the coming years. The contractor will install on Monday. We also have holiday



banners going up from 7th to Park. We are using the same designer as the "All in This Together" banners, but they are festive.

WE are still going to be in the black, but not by much. We have trimmed down expenses such as block party expenses and looked into income. A Lot of what happens depends on parking funds, but not much to know until the end of year.

Diane: Budget for next year and what our priorities are in case our budget is cut. We will then know what the structure will be and how to use our funds. What came out is to see if Ben will allow us to roll over funds from this year into next year. Ben is open to it as it will be helpful to them and put less pressure for them to make up the difference. He will talk to his boss and get back next week.

Justin: Any feedback on impact since we hired Ambassadors.

Terry: I see them everyday. There is a higher concentration

Justin: The block feels hotter, but I do see them everyday. I can't imagine what we would be talking about now if we did not hire these two looking at the rising numbers.

Hasan: The job that Alonso and his ambassadors do is outstanding. They have done the best to the max. One thing that is going on and it happened in March and again has started. It goes with COVID and how many problems we are going through. It was happening to us and it started again with panhandlers. They are much more dangerous. Every time we call Alonso's team they respond in minutes.

Alonso: They are working the swing shift, so let us know if we should adjust this. If there are any placemaking events where we will need to flex our schedule for these let us know.

Hasan: Does anyone know what was going on in the stadium with a shooting range?

James: I believe it was a SWAT training

Ken: We worked with SDPD to do their SWAT training. It is now done. We do not plan on hosting those anymore. I can make sure in the future we share it with this group. We do share with the community.

Hasan: I did not receive a notice, but I would like to receive a notice for anything that will cause noise exceeding the decibel regulations. East Village Association should be able to approve this at all.

Ken: I will make sure that this gets shared with this group. I do not foresee us hosting these trainings in the future.

James: Was this the first one?

Ken: Yes, the first one to this extent.
