# <u>Russell Warner SD Street Banner Installation</u> <u>Comments/Suggestions on EV Banner Rental Inquiries</u>

- Reported that DSDP, GQA, and La Jolla Merchants Association all charge in the range of \$20-\$30 per banner per month for banner rental rates.
- Contended that any value higher typically results in reduced business interest and, as a result, reduced revenue to the Association for banner rental inquiries.
  - Commented that a full banner buyout, especially given the size of EVA's banner pole jurisdiction, will rarely occur.
  - Suggested enforcing a minimum requirement for the number of banners to be rented i.e. 30 banners minimum.
- Suggested a policy where non-profits receive a more affordable rate as opposed to larger, corporate businesses.
- Commented that clients are often interested in a one-to-two-week banner pole rental, suggested adopting a minimum rental period.




