HOW TO BECOME A BOARD MEMBER

On January 1, 2023, the terms of 6 of the 15 Members of the Board of Directors will end. All property owners within the boundaries of the LA Fashion District BID, or their representative, are invited to submit their candidacy for a seat on the Board of Directors.

A general election will be held in November. **ALL** district property owners, who are current on assessments, are invited to vote for the candidates of their choice for Board of Directors. Six (6) elected candidates will serve a 3-year term. All terms begin on January 1, 2022.

If you are interested in running, please:

- (1) **Submit Intent of Candidacy**
- (2) **Fill out a Candidate Profile**

The deadline for receiving both documents is Friday, September 30th, 2022, at 5:00 PM.

Please note that candidate must comply with the below requirements:

- (1) Be a member in good standing with all assessments paid in full or the representative of a member in good standing with all assessments paid in full.
- (2) Not have been convicted of a felony or judged to be mentally incompetent.
- (3) Confirm that there is no impediment to his or her ability to attend and participate in the required number of meetings (8) of the board and committees.
- (4) Not be related to any of the following directors whose terms will continue during 2023: Mark Chatoff, Margot Garcia, Eric Kim, Steven Kim, Lisa Korbatov, Dean Nucich, Diane Pappas, Laurie Rosen, and Brian Taban.
- (5) Not be related to any candidate who has earlier complied with the election procedures set forth in this section. ("Related" is defined as persons related to the candidate by blood such as parent, child, brother, sister; by marriage such as husband, wife, brother-in-law, sister-in-law, father-in-law, mother-in-law, son-in-law, and daughter-in-law; and persons, corporations or other entities that share any ownership interest with a returning member and any candidate); and
