### MINUTES

I. The meeting was called to order at 8:34 AM.

#### II. Clean (Ambassador Report, Garbage, Landscaping) –

- a) Ambassador report – Per the dumpsters and trash pickup with midvalley, Services will be starting this week, servicing them as they service the Van Ness cans, replacing plastic liners when melted or removed, dumping regularly. Friday morning service from MidValley. Kern street cfarmers marker on Wednesday, pickup might be better for Tuesday., lee says it's a good idea temporarily, if jimmy is okay, temp shift to a tuesday pickup, Friday was selected for art hop, jayt confiems Tuesday will be next week.

Jay and Lee discussed the unappeal that they currently have, right now two sets of black trash cans, 2 sets of brownt rash cans. Possible rrepaint and

Jay suggests that repairs are necessary but the paint is an optional idea.

Lee says current locking cans go from ventura to Stanislaus, after calaveras, thre is a chain to hold the can and lid in, San Joaquin and Amador, few more of brown fully locking trash cans,

Jimmy asks if cans don't have lids, can they support a lid. Jay says all cans with metal structures all look good, inserts we need to replace,

- b) Garbage – some dunmpsters have been replaced from the last report, which ones to mark off, etc, whichever ones still required. Email from Bank of the West, needs additional dunmpsters, but other ebusinesness hasn't been actually open, Lee and team will do outreach to get contact info for businesses, and as far as they know Midvalley won't be doing new locking systems just yet.

Midvalley – lots of flux with services and syuspended services, bin exchanges will continue but gravity locaks and additional things

Lee will complete product review for dumpsters and report.

### MINUTES

Jimmy reports the Fulton Street at night is trash, and is that people getting trash from Fulton Casn. Lee says that may be – it's very obvious that trash is right next to it, etc, blows through alleyway. Etc

Informed that county building that shares alleyway with downtown club has not been locking their dumpsters, the county building has been given notice (through door), will notify downtown club

City services will be doing alleyway, but commercial trash services – MidValley will find a resolution,

Jay = locking lids, letter sent in March, has it been suspended because of COVID – etc, we were gearing up to fulfill throughout the PBID, Lupe said

Jerry said that dumpsters can't have metal lids – locking and metal lids ordinance, no change. All PBID areas are required to have a locking lid.

- c) Landscaping – Jimmy - Jerry may know about this, number of broken sprinklers, reported through FresGo, public works would know about that – would go directly to that division or department, but if not fixed that Jerry can reach out to Erin and Gary, median island crew, Lee said he only noticed one sprinkler system off

### III. COVID-19 Updates

Indoor dining, county and city update – spoke with TJ Miller, still pushing for outdoor dining, governor putting a hot spot design, trying to control cases and capacity that is in the hospital, we won't be in consideration, the task force is finding out the core issues to report back to the governor, outdoor dining is something. Outdoor dining – spoke with Drew Wilson - planning, what we can do with private property and city property, what we need insurance wise for the risk team, Lupe is working with Aldi and Thomas on getting things up on the website, the resolution is just up there, tower district committee is going to use \$25,000 each – and we allocated. They can apply for a parklet now, but invoicing and funding if it will go to the business directly, they just talked to businesses that wanted it. It needs to be the business owner. Daniel has spoken with Kocky;s and working with Fulton Street coffee, Thomas has been talking with insurance and risk and working around that, willing to allow some of this to move forward. Planning is waiving the permits, and close to zero, CARES money will be going toward the cost of building the parklet, building the parklet, etc. Modernist and Nora Monaco have been working with Thomas as well. Outdoor dining, already approved but now it's how much quicker we can do it.

Lupe will talk to greeg about moving the bench over, he's been upset, employees fee threatened, Yarra Law group
