Franklin-Argyle Underground Power Transmission Project

Project Description

The Franklin-Argyle Underground Power Transmission Project is an emergency project made necessary after an equipment failure recently in one of our underground vaults near the intersection of Franklin Ave. and Argyle Ave. in Hollywood.

Notifications will be distributed directly to affected customers prior to the outages.

Construction Information

Construction will take place along a stretch of Franklin Ave. between Argyle Ave. and Canyon Dr. In order to complete this project as quickly and as safely as possible, work will occur seven days a week for approximately two to three months. Work hours are M-F 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and on Sat. and Sun. from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

During work hours, traffic will be reduced to one lane in each direction on Franklin Ave. along that stretch. Traffic will be returned to normal at the end of each work day.

That event caused underground transmission lines to be damaged and left exposed to the elements. The lines in question pose no danger to the general public. We need to complete the necessary repairs and equipment upgrades as quickly as possible before the rainy season begins in order to preserve the reliability of electric service in the area. Planned outages will take place at the conclusion of the project to energize the upgraded equipment.

All parking on Franklin within the work area will be restricted. Traffic Control Officers will be on-site at intersections to help keep traffic moving. Electronic message boards will be in place to notify motorists of the work. Deliveries and emergency services will continue as normal. Driveway access will not be affected.

We thank our neighbors in advance for their patience as we make these necessary repairs.
