Downtown SLO is seeking an Event Operations Assistant to produce the weekly summer Concerts in the Plaza series every Friday between June - September. Qualified candidates are strong collaborators, dedicated to customer service, and able to think on their feet while producing one of SLO's most iconic community events. This role involves lifting heavy objects, setting up event equipment, and working with/serving alcohol. You will work directly with seasoned Event staff & student interns to transform Mission Plaza into a bustling free & family-friendly concert venue, presenting a wide variety of music genres from local & traveling talent.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Execute daily event production timeline to ensure all aspects are completed as planned.
- Assist Events Manager in receiving talent, loading in vendors, and ensuring that event materials are organized for day-of setup.
- Work with a high level of service, communication, and teamwork.
- Supervision of Concerts in the Plaza's Beer/Cider satellite bar, including maintaining stock, handling cash, and working with interns & volunteers.
- Work around alcohol, manage a POS system and handle cash as necessary.

- Act as a liaison between event attendees and event staff & interns as needed.
- Attention to crowd flow, venue cleanliness, event regulations, and public safety.
- Break down, return and maintenance of all equipment and supplies to proper storage.
- Interact with staff, volunteers, sponsors and event guests in a professional and ethical manner.
- Perform other duties as necessary to assist the organization.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS:

- Stand/Walk for prolonged periods of time
- Lift and move materials up to 50lbs
- Maneuver on grounds at night at dusk and dark
- Work in an outdoor environment subject to weather
- Comfortable working in noisy environments moderate to very loud
