DOWNTOWN STREET IMPROVEMENTS

Starting Construction September 2022

In September 2022, construction to improve downtown streets, bike lanes and sidewalks will begin. The work will include roadway sealing in downtown and is scheduled to be completed ahead of the busy holiday shopping season.


Downtown improvements coming soon:

- On-street accessible parking spaces
- High visibility crosswalks
- Street resealing and repaving
- Buffered and parking-protected bike lanes on Marsh and Higuera Streets
- Extending the two-vehicle lane configuration of Marsh Street through the downtown core

Street improvements are coming soon to the downtown core.

These improvements are part of the City’s efforts to keep SLO in Motion, through projects that will boost mobility, replace aging infrastructure, connect communities, and maintain our streets.

We appreciate your patience as we work on these key community improvements to foster a more accessible, vibrant and welcoming downtown core.

We’re investing in the downtown area.

The City is investing more than \$11 million on the SLO in Motion improvements. These projects are part of the City’s continuing commitment to the long-term economic vitality of the downtown SLO area. Partnering with businesses is an important priority for the City.

Together, these enhancements will make it easier and safer to travel to and through downtown SLO whether in a car, on a bike or on foot, while creating key neighborhood connections and safe routes to area schools.

We’re striving to minimize impacts as much as possible.

We are working block-by-block to limit the inconveniences of active construction. Temporary, phased street closures will last for approximately one to two business days, and businesses will be notified in advance. During construction, access to sidewalks, driveways and businesses will be maintained, and the City’s construction team will coordinate with individual businesses to facilitate deliveries during construction.

We chose to start this portion of the improvements in the fall to avoid the busy summer tourist season.

We want to stay connected.
