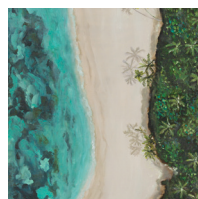
**1 VOICE Gallery**

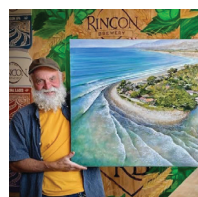
**2 Art & Soul**

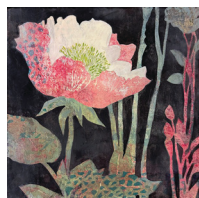

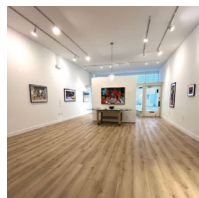

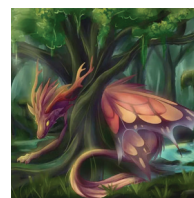
