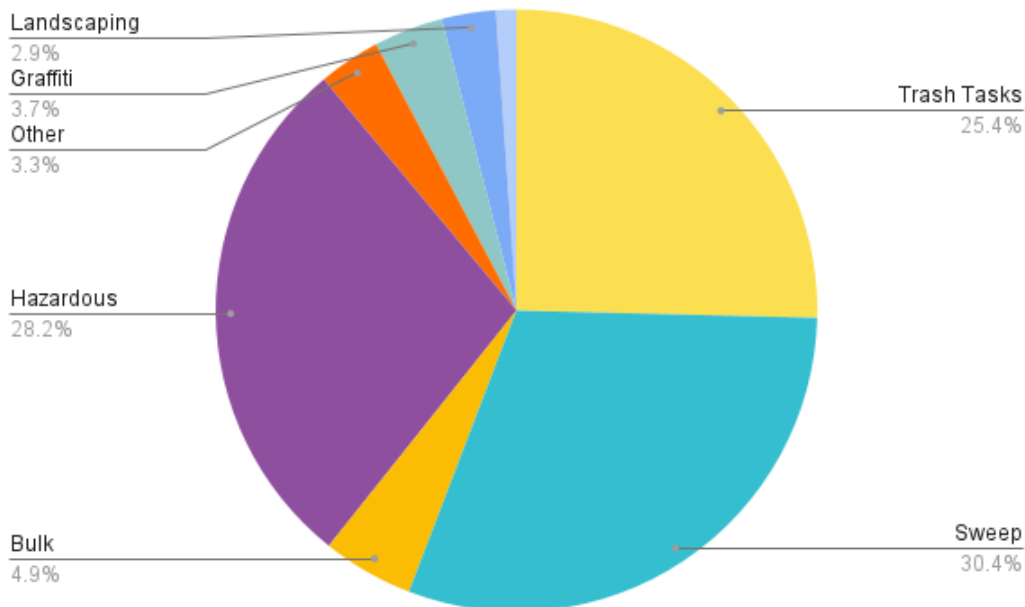

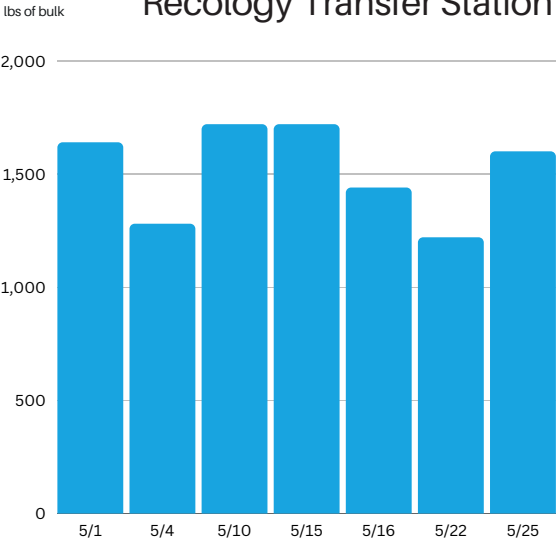

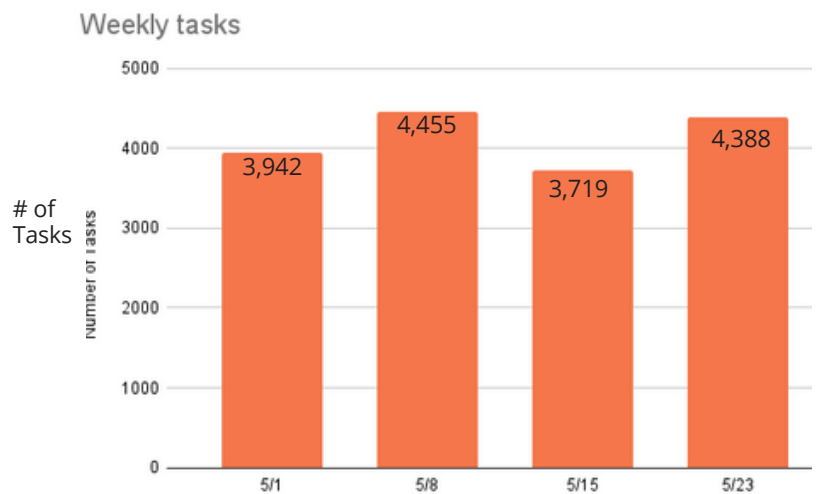

Employees of the Month

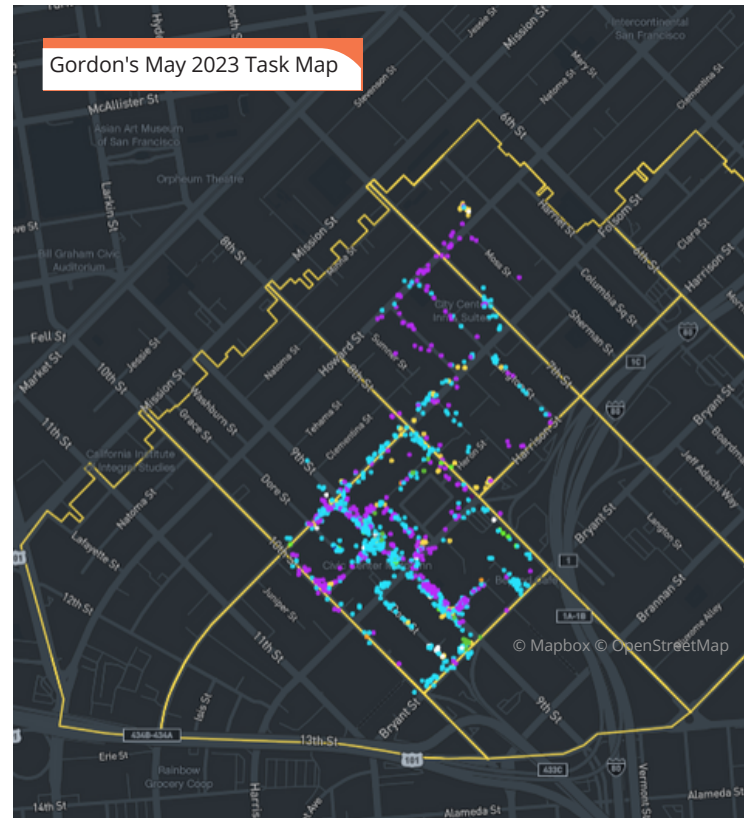
For May 2023, we are proud to share that we have two employees of the month! Both stood out in different ways; we wanted to recognize them for their excellence.



Gordon Rowe



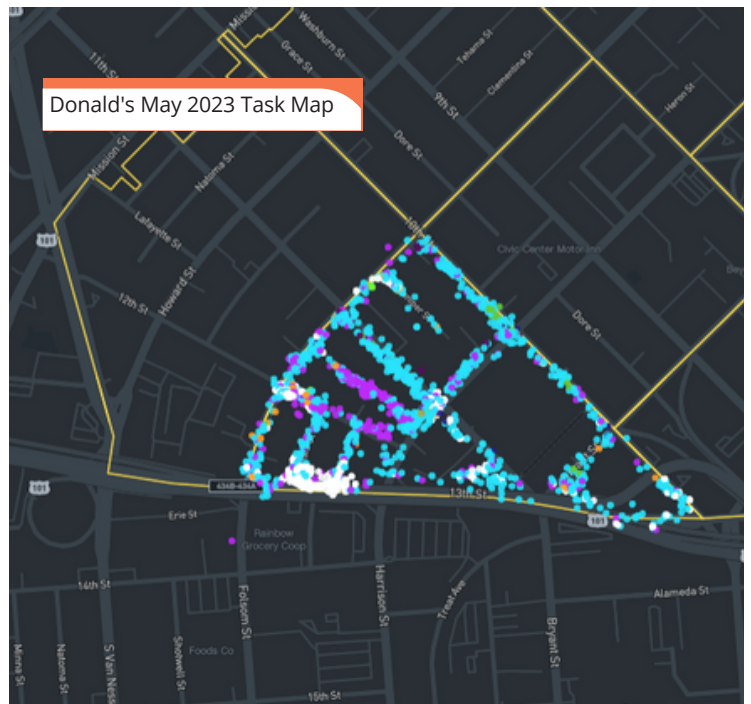

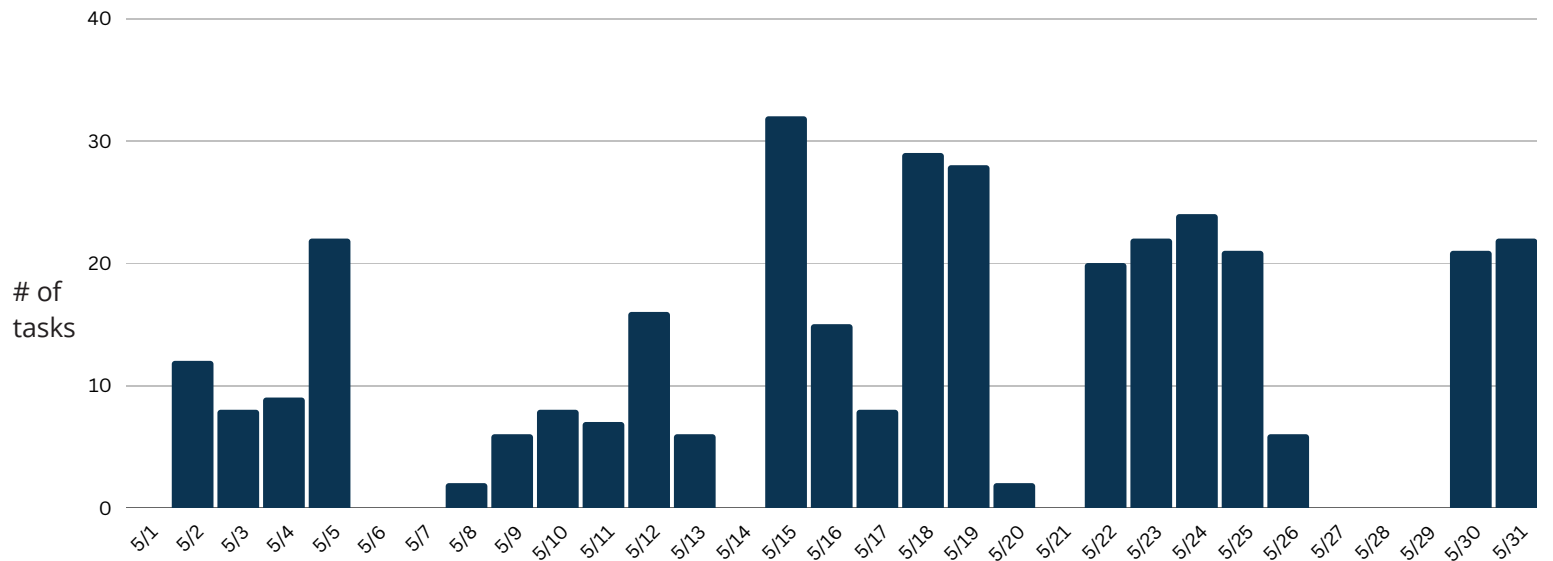

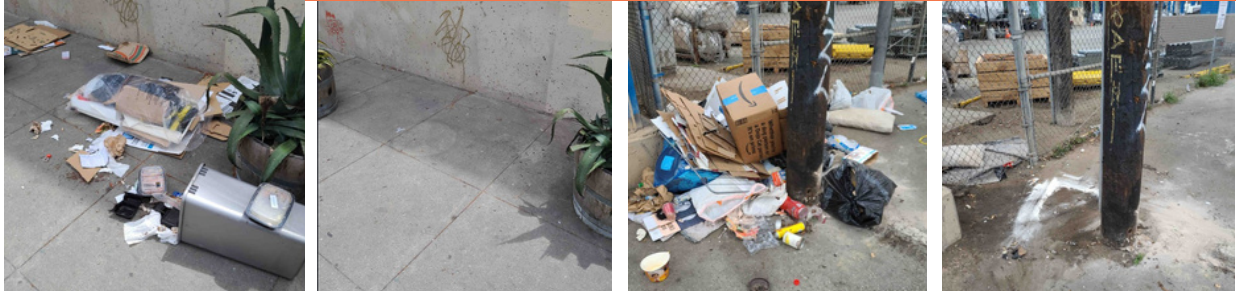

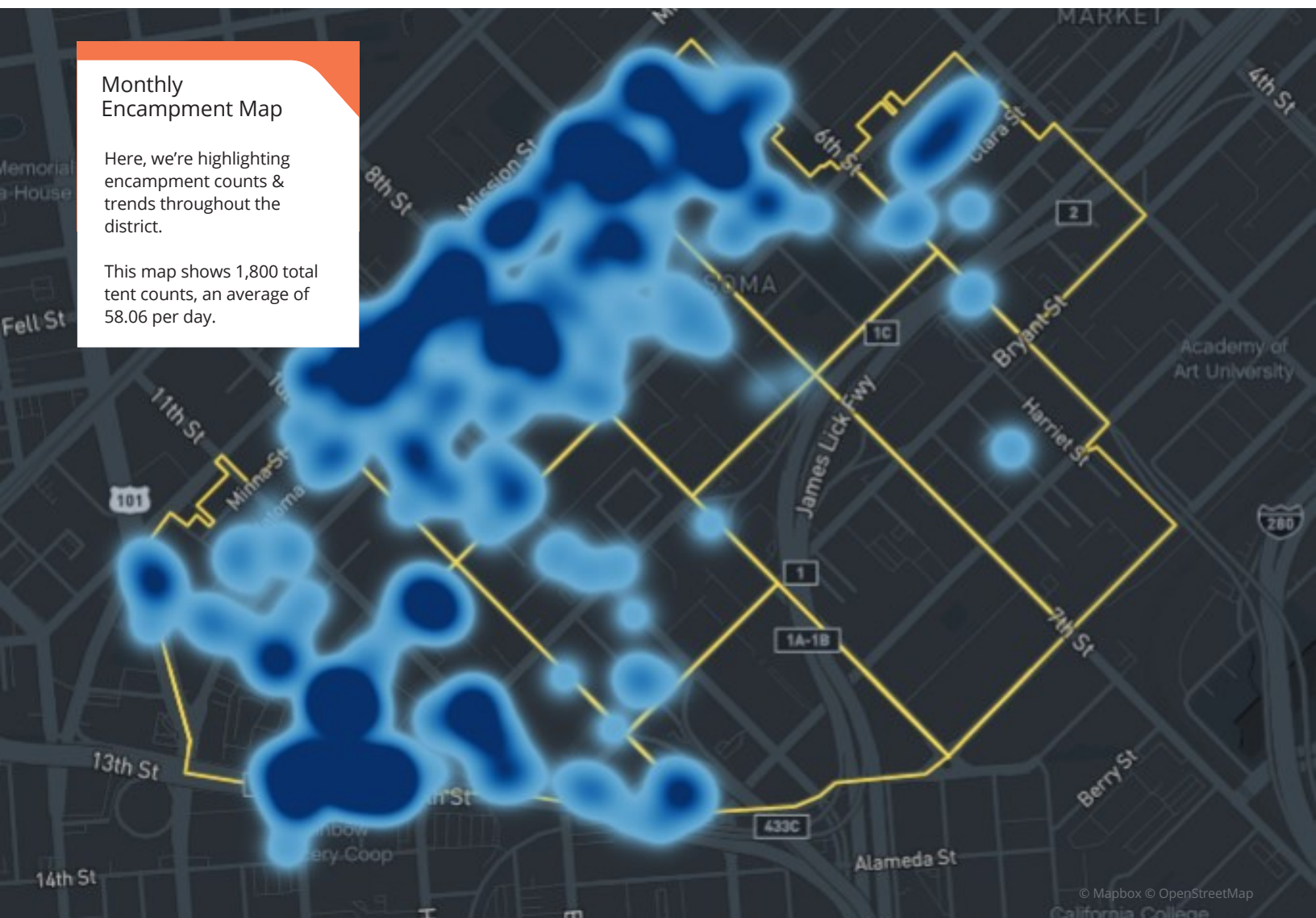
