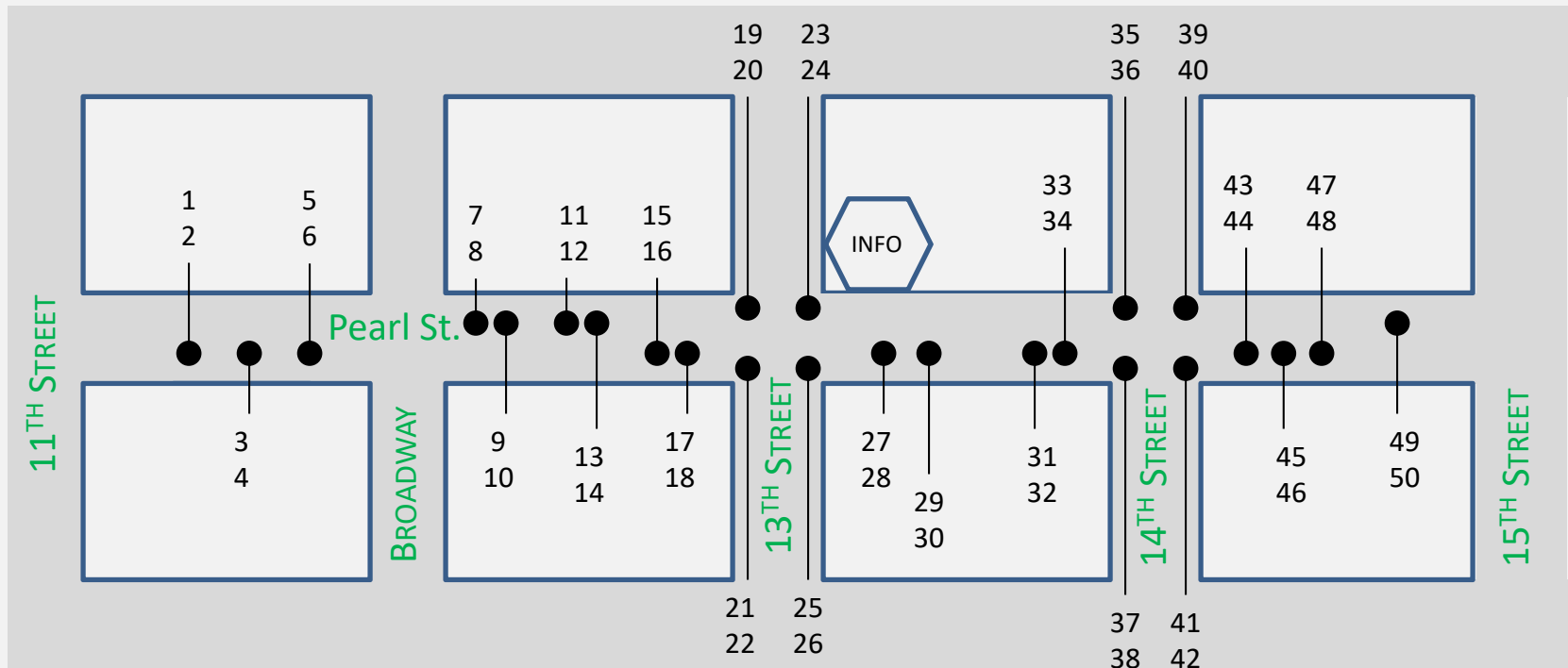
Mediums used to create the banners range from pencil art and water colors to collage. The banners will be on display through mid-April 2021.
