

## <u>Description of Façade Project:</u>

- Restoration and or reproduction of the stained glass windows that were damaged in the two vandalism incidents that took place on August 11, 2022, and on August 24, 2022. There is a total of 12 damaged stained glass windows. 10 windows are being repaired by Lucia's Glass in Fort Collins, these are the reproduction widows which were made around 43 years ago (3M, 6T, 6M, 6B, 7T, 7M, 7B, 8T, 8M, 8B). Two of the windows Angela Anderson is donating her time to repair (windows 11 & 12), these were made by her in 2010 as part of the Past President, David Schey Memorial.
- Replacement of the damaged safety glass panels (windows 6, 7, 8, 11 and 12) and replacing the remaining existing safety glass with a polycarbonate which will hold up to vandalism in the future. This also includes adding a polycarbonate covering to the bottom windows of 1, 2, 3, 6, 7, and 8, where there is no current protection and to the clear glass windows 13 and 14, on the east side of the Church. The current safety glass is laminated glass which is easily broken.

# <u>Briefly describe how your project meets the Goals and Strategies of the Downtown Longmont</u> <u>Master Plan of Development:</u>

This is part of a rehabilitation project that will bring the "Old" St. Stephen's Church up to standards in keeping with maintaining the historic character and identity of the Downtown Creative District. Additionally, this project will further protect this historic building while showcasing Longmont's unique history. These changes, especially with the addition of the polycarbonate glass will also uphold the goals of the master plan by deterring future vandalism and thus making the St. Stephen's Plaza a safe and welcoming space for all.



Hi Angela,

I studied the damage to all 10 windows. There are a few that need total restoration, while the others can be repaired in only the areas which were damaged. My total bid will not exceed \$15,0000. This includes all materials ,total repair and transport. I will keep a log as to the hours I put in at \$50.00 per hour along with the occasional hours of an assistant at \$25.00 an hour. I will pick up and already paid for the glass at D&L.

I have an A frame rack to transport the damaged windows and the return of the finished windows to the site. I have a \$2,000,000 liability policy with State Farm. I will provide pictures as the work progresses. I will need a 50% deposit to proceed.
