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Art RiNo Festival Brings Three Days of Art, Food, Music and Community to RiNo October 2–4

Three-day festival includes a 21+ culinary experience, free outdoor arts and music festival, new public art across the district, and place-based beer tasting

Denver, CO — RiNo Art District will present **Art RiNo Festival October 2–4**, bringing art, music, food, public art, and community programming to locations throughout the RiNo Art District. The three-day festival features [RiNo Eats](#) on Friday, the free [Art RiNo Festival](#) at RiNo ArtPark on Saturday, and [Beers Made By Walking](#) on Sunday, with live mural painting happening across the district throughout the weekend.

RiNo's iconic fall mural festival tradition continues throughout the weekend, including a three-day live-painting [Mural Jam](#) in the Graffiti Gardens Alley and EDENS lot on Larimer Street, featuring artists tukeone, Chelsea Lewinski, Adden Joule, emit, Mike Graves, and Patrick Kane McGregor, as well as a [mural dedication](#) featuring a new piece by artist Moe Gram. The mural activations continue RiNo Art District's longstanding support for public art and artist-led creative work while expanding Art RiNo beyond a single venue.

New Public Art Across The District

Art RiNo continues a long-running tradition of fall mural festivals in the district, with new public art planned throughout the weekend. Created by local and visiting artists, the murals will offer visitors additional ways to experience art throughout the weekend (and beyond) while contributing to the layered visual character of the district.

At the [Mural Jam on Larimer Street](#), **tukeone** will lead five collaborating artists (**Emit, Mike Graves, Adden Joule, Chelsea Lewinski & Patrick Kane McGregor**) in creating a new mural live over three days. Visitors can drop in to watch the artists work in the EDENS Lot and Graffiti Gardens Alley behind Denver Central Market. The free activation will continue throughout the weekend, with a DJ performance organized by the artists on Sunday afternoon following Beers Made By Walking.

At RiNo ArtPark, a new mural by Moe Gram will be on view during the festival, with a [dedication](#) at 12:45 PM on Saturday, October 3, just before the festival begins.

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Together with the weekend's exhibitions, performances, culinary experiences, and community programming, the mural activations reinforce Art RiNo Festival's district-wide approach to celebrating the people and creative work that shape RiNo.

"There is no better feeling than creating something beautiful with your friends," said **tukeone**, renowned muralist and lead organizer of the **October Art RiNo Mural Jam**.

Friday, October 2 — RiNo Eats

The weekend begins Friday, October 2, with [RiNo Eats](#), a ticketed 21+ tasting experience bringing together restaurants from across the district for an evening of food, art, and live entertainment. Guests will sample offerings from participating restaurants while experiencing an exhibition of historic neon signs from the Denver area in collaboration with Save the Signs, music from Golden Bell DJ Duo, aerial performances from Circus Foundry, and pop-up improvisational performances from OddKnock Productions.

RiNo Eats takes place Friday, October 2, from **6–9 PM** at RiNo ArtPark and Truss House. **Early bird ticket pricing is available through September 14.**

Saturday, October 3 — Art RiNo Festival

On Saturday, October 3, [Art RiNo](#) takes over RiNo ArtPark for a **free, all-ages outdoor festival** centered on live music, visual art, artist-led experiences, and community programming.

The festival kicks off with the dedication of a new mural by **Moe Gram**, followed by a full afternoon of live music, art, and creative programming throughout RiNo ArtPark. The outdoor music stage, curated by **Tohbias Juniel**, features five artists performing throughout the day from 1–8 PM, while the Truss House and Welcome Center Galleries showcase art and historic neon signs, alongside live neon glass bending demonstrations by **JJ Bebout** and guided mural tours through the park. Food trucks and a curated market of local artists and makers will be on site throughout the festival, with additional artist activations and open artist studios to explore.

Sunday, October 4 — Beers Made By Walking

The weekend concludes Sunday, October 4, with [Beers Made By Walking](#), a program that connects craft beer with the natural environment through guided exploration and tasting.

The day begins with a **free, all-ages guided nature walk from 10 AM to noon**, offering participants a closer look at the places, stories, and natural features that inspired this year's beers. A ticketed **21+ beer tasting follows from 2–4:30 PM**,

featuring unique beers inspired by the landscapes, ecology, history, and character of RiNo. A limited VIP Brewers Tasting will also take place before the main event.

Early bird ticket pricing for the beer tasting is available through September 14.

A Weekend Rooted in Art and Community

Art RiNo brings together programs that reflect the breadth of creativity found throughout the district while supporting RiNo Art District's mission to support artists, creative businesses, and communities across the historic north Denver neighborhoods of Five Points, Cole, Globeville, and Elyria-Swansea.
