



WINTER PREP IN THE DUPONT CIRCLE BID

Get ready for the season ahead! As we transition from fall to winter in the coming weeks, the Dupont Circle Clean Team is prepared for the snow.



The District Snow Team is comprised of the Department of Public Works (DPW) and the District Department of Transportation (DDOT), with the assistance of other DC gov agencies.



The Dupont Circle Clean Team will be prepping the snow blower and purchasing the necessary supplies to ensure safety and movement if and/or when severe winter weather arrives.



Businesses & Property Owners, if you have concerns about the treatment or plowing of specific roads, call the Citywide Call Center by dialing 311.



District Snow Team is responsible for:

- Clearing streets of snow and ice in streets to promote safe vehicular travel
- Reminder: The District does not plow alleys

The Clean Team is responsible for:

- Pre-treating handicapped ramps, bus stops, curbs and fire hydrants before snow falls
- Clearing snow from sidewalks, bus stops and fire hydrants
- Checking storefronts and public space

Businesses & Commercial Property Owners are responsible for:

- Clearing snow and ice from the sidewalk in front of the building within 24 hours of a storm's end
- Clearing snow from outdoor dining spaces such as streateries and parklets

The décor will be installed on street poles in the BID boundary, including Connecticut Ave, P Street, Massachusetts Ave, Florida Ave, and around Dupont Circle Park.
