

Capital Projects Program Management Support RFQ Responses

1. Are covers and dividers permissible for inclusion, and if so, are they excluded from the page count?

Yes, covers and dividers may be included in the submission and are excluded from the page count.

2. Is the Peachtree Shared Space project listed in the RFQ the same as the existing Peachtree project with a PI # of 17994?

No, the Peachtree Shared Space project listed in the RFQ is distinct from the Peachtree Street SW Streetscape Enhancement Project (PI 0017794). Peachtree Shared Space has been awarded ARC LCI funding for design and has funding allocated in the Moving Atlanta Forward (TSPLOST 2.0) program for construction.

3. Are resumes, a cover page, tabs, forms, organizational chart, and budget (hourly rates) included or not in the page count?

Resumes, forms, organizational chart, and budget are included in the page count. Cover pages and tabs are not.

4. Has the City of Atlanta approved funding for the Baker Street Two-Way Conversion and the Peachtree Street Shared Street projects? If the projects do not receive funding from the City of Atlanta, will the selected projects be removed from consideration?

Baker Street and Peachtree Shared Space have been allocated funding (TSPLOST 1.0 and 2.0, respectively) but are awaiting approval to proceed from the City of Atlanta. If either project does not get approval, it will be removed from consideration until approval is received. However, both projects are currently expected to move forward.

5. The RFP mentioned that additional projects with smaller budgets are also in the pipeline and may require program management support. Can you provide a list and description of these projects?

All known projects are included in the RFQ. However, as the program grows and evolves over time, future projects are anticipated. An example of a smaller project that may require program management support is the two-way restoration of Walton Street in the Fairlie Poplar District.
