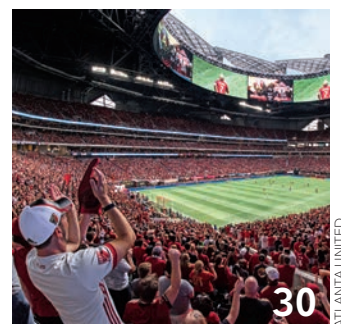

WHAT IS THE CENTENNIAL PARK DISTRICT?

In the early 1990s, Atlanta Committee for the Olympic Games (ACOG) CEO Billy Payne looked out of his office in Downtown Atlanta and saw a bleak landscape between the city's central business and hospitality core and future Olympic venues. ACOG raised \$75 million in private funds to redevelop the area into an inviting park for visitors and residents. The result was one of the first urban infill parks in the country: Centennial Olympic Park. The area immediately attracted developers, restaurateurs and visionaries. Now, the District has grown into an iconic destination showcasing attractions, sporting events, special events, restaurants, lounges and hotels.

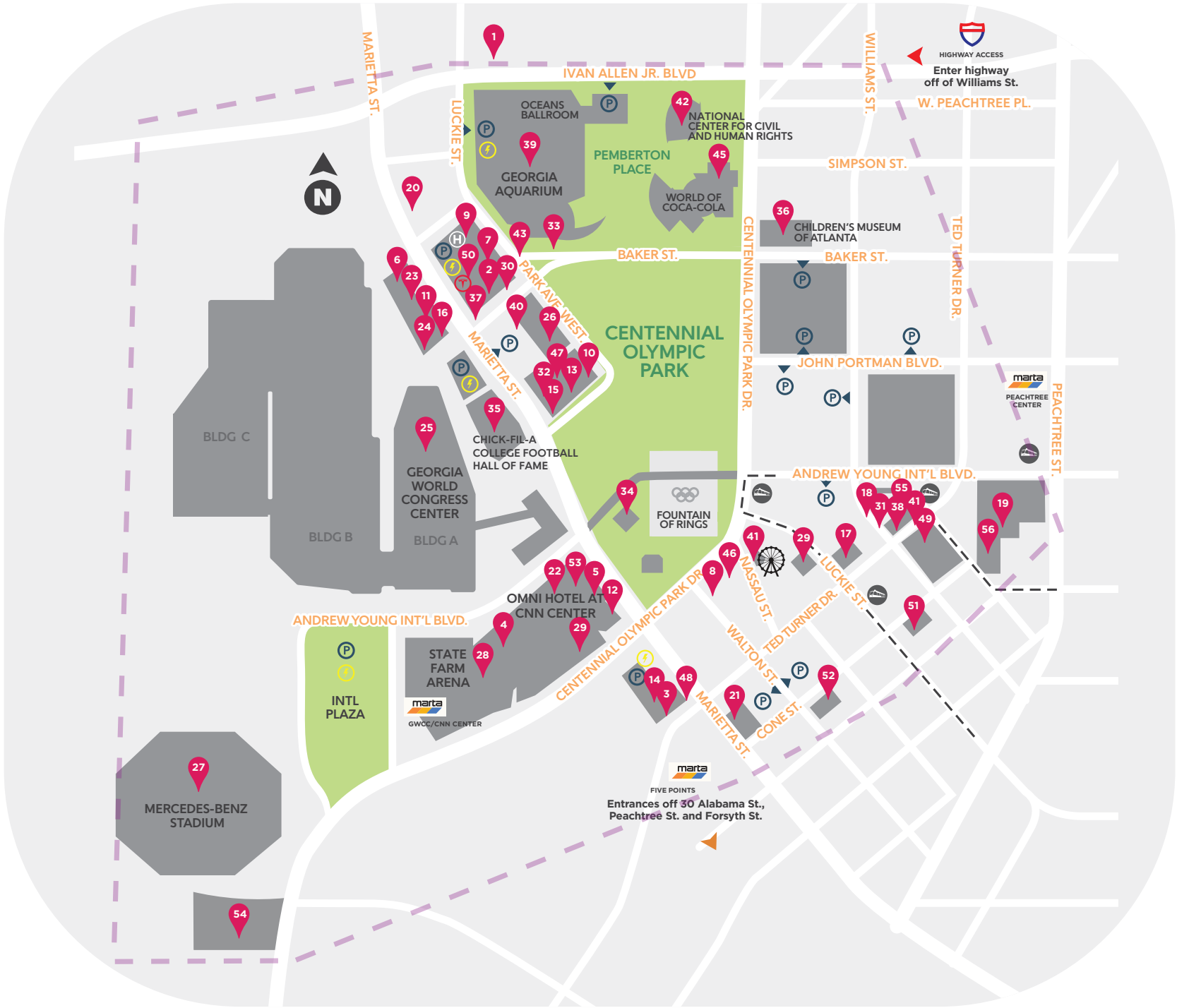

GETTING AROUND

It’s easy to explore the District on foot, but if you’d rather rest your feet, here are some options on how to get around.



METROPOLITAN ATLANTA RAPID TRANSIT AUTHORITY (MARTA)
The Centennial Park District is within walking distance of four MARTA train stations GWCC / CNN Center (East/West); Vine City (East/ West); Five Points (North/ South/East /West connections); and Peachtree Center (North/ South). Trains and buses operate weekdays, weekends and holidays. Frequencies and schedules are adjusted by time of day.

ATLANTA STREETCAR
Managed by MARTA, the Atlanta Streetcar connects some of Atlanta’s popular sites and attractions. Single trip fare is \$1; multiple trip passes are available.

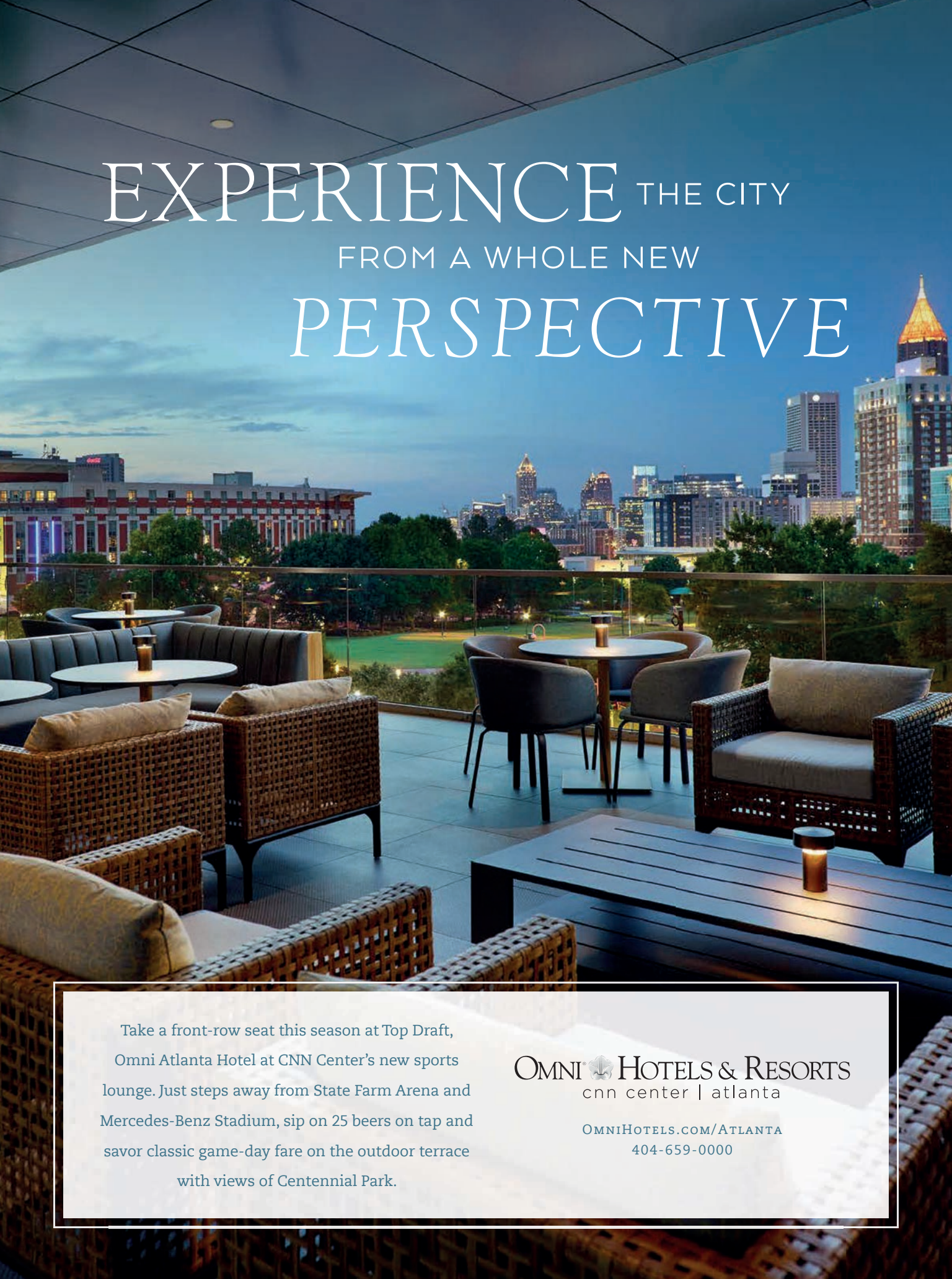
RIDESHARE
Lyft, Uber and taxis are all available in Atlanta and provide easy access for visitors to view all the must-see places in the city.

DOCKLESS SCOOTERS
Dockless scooters make short trips easier and provide a fun way to explore the city. BIRD, Lime and Spin scooters are available for use and are located in various areas of the city. Simply download an app, and you can locate the nearest scooter, as well as unlock it from the app.

RELAY BIKE SHARE
Relay Bikeshare is powered by Atlanta|HOPR. Find and reserve a bike through the app, then release it by entering a 4-digit code. Ride, and then lock your bike to a station when you’re finished.

Bike paths, rack locations are prevalent in the District and MARTA is bike-friendly. Every bus has a rack for bicycles and the MARTA trains allow bikes as well.

- 1 OCEAN VOYAGER AT GEORGIA AQUARIUM**
Ocean Voyager, one of the largest single aquatic exhibits in the world, just so happens to house the largest fish in the world (whale sharks). Sit in front of the large picture window and capture not only the stunning whale sharks but Manta rays, goliath grouper and other swimming species.
- 2 ON TOP OF SKYVIEW ATLANTA**
Capture city lights at new heights on SkyView Atlanta Ferris wheel, across from Centennial Olympic Park. Buy a ticket, hop aboard and soar high above the city.
- 3 NATIONAL CENTER FOR CIVIL AND HUMAN RIGHTS FOUNTAIN**
Behind National Center for Civil and Human Rights facing Ivan Allen Jr. Boulevard stands a remarkable water feature depicting quotations by Nelson Mandela and Margaret Mead.
- 4 THE SPECTACULAR**
In Centennial Olympic Park, this 11-foot aluminum sculpture depicts the Olympic rings and is located at Andrew Young International Blvd. and Centennial Olympic Park Drive (across from Waffle House).
- 5 ACVB VISITOR CENTER MURAL**
The Atlanta Convention & Visitors Bureau Visitor Information Center in Centennial Olympic Park proudly displays a colorful new interactive Atlanta mural by Lotus Eaters Club that features not one, but three Tiny Doors, part of a citywide art project called Tiny Doors Atlanta.

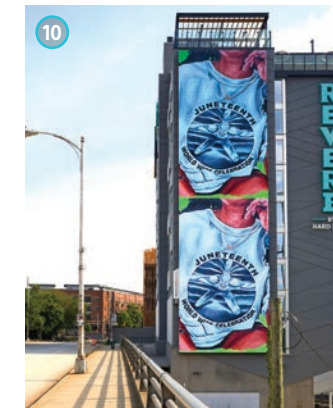

- 6 TELSTAR SOCCER BALL AT MERCEDEZ-BENZ STADIUM**
This truly eye-catching piece overlooks Home Depot Backyard outside of the stadium. The mirrored, 25-foot round sculpture of a soccer ball has 186 reflecting surfaces that catch the sun at different points during the day.
- 7 THE GLENN HOTEL MURAL**
Travel to this hip, happening hotel to snap a picture of the colorful city skyline mural painted on the side. A brilliant sun rises from the skyline, and the word Atlanta artfully displayed at the bottom makes this a perfect Insta-worthy shot.
- 8 FALCON STATUE**
This 73,000-pound, gleaming statue of a falcon with outstretched wings making a touchdown outside of Mercedes-Benz Stadium looms above fans as they stream inside to catch a game.
- 9 PEMBERTON PLACE LAWN**
Situated between World of Coca-Cola, Georgia Aquarium and National Center for Civil and Human Rights, the expansive green lawn and beautiful downtown skyline make for splendid shots.
- 10 ARTS & ENTERTAINMENT ATLANTA**
Downtown Atlanta has been filled with light, art and cultural programming through Arts & Entertainment Atlanta. New outdoor media, local art, accent lighting and digital and static signage all blend together to activate buildings and blank walls. - 11 THE YARD MILKSHAKE BAR**
