

About Midtown Green

Our public works team keeps Midtown sidewalks, parks and plazas looking good.

Midtown Green provides daily maintenance, cleanup and repairs in the public realm, all of which contributes to the best possible urban experience in Midtown.

For a cleaner, greener, safer Midtown.

Midtown Green is on the job every day removing trash and graffiti, planting new landscaping, repainting light poles, cleaning fixtures, reporting issues to the City and keeping the public right of way in tip-top shape.

Our team also reports and tracks infrastructure issues - such as street light outages and repairs needed after fiber install crews dig up streets - with the City to achieve resolution.

Midtown Alliance functions - and especially our Midtown Green maintenance crew - were deemed by the State as essential services at the outset of the pandemic, and we have been on duty every day, working hard to keep pace with operations and maintenance needs.

Positive Impact

Midtown Green operations serve more than 120 city blocks in Midtown's central business district.

What We Do

- Collect trash and debris every week
- **Maintain** public parks, plazas, medians and gateway areas
- Clean debris out of storm drains to make sure the storm water system works well
- **Perform** landscaping duties to improve safety and line of sight
- **Pressure wash** sidewalks and plazas on the public right of way
- Address ADA and safety issues along sidewalks
- Manage public equipment, from games to seating
- **Execute** repairs for tree well fencing and street furniture
- Plant and care for 2,700+ street trees along sidewalks plus seasonal annuals
