

A CLEAN CAR IS A SAFE CAR


Before you park and leave your vehicle, remember these three steps:

Your Role in a Safer Midtown

Public safety is a shared responsibility. Help the Midtown Blue team do the best job they can do by doing the best job you can:

- If you observe a situation or person's behavior that looks out of place, report it by calling 911 and then dial Midtown Blue at 404-817-0500.
- Lock your vehicle and remove all valuables. Every trip.
- Do not hold the door open for strangers or let them follow you inside when you enter secured buildings.
- Never prop doors open to a building.
- Always park in a designated parking area when you need to run into a store to pick up an item. Do not leave your car parked illegally at the curb.
