Business & Property Owner Responsibilities

Holiday Lights:

• We love the holiday spirit but it is time for the sunny season! Don't forget to bring down those holiday lights.

Tree Irrigation:

 Turn on your irrigation system, this helps keep trees thriving throughout the summer.

Street Drains:

Avoid sweeping large piles of debris into the streets. This can block street drains and flood sidewalks.

<u>Trash Responsibilities:</u>

- Business and property owners have access to their own alley dumpsters. Please avoid throwing large and/or heavy items into street trash cans.
- Trash trails. When throwing large bags of trash into the dumpster, please mop up any liquid trash and/or grease trails left on the sidewalks.

Animal & Dog Care:

Encourage customers and community members to clean up after their animals and dogs. This will help keep the streets clear of any fecal matter that can be dragged into businesses.

Graffiti:

 It is the owner's responsibility to remove graffiti on their property. Graffiti on public services can be reported directly to City of Boise dispatch at: (208) 377-6790. If you need further assistance, you can also contact us.
