## Downtown Maintenance Team Impact

In addition to their daily work of trash removal, sidewalk cleaning, flume removal, event clean-up, etc. They begin to prep for sunshine activities for the community!

Grove Plaza Furniture:  
Chairs, tables, and sun shade sails are available to the public. Furniture is usually set-up mid-April

Grove Plaza Fountain & Splash Pad:  
The splash pad is turned on by Memorial Day. If the weather is consistently sunny, it will be turned on early! Maintenance is done weekly to ensure cleanliness.

Flower Installation:  
Cement planters around the Business Improvement District are planted in May and maintain by ProCare throughout the Summer and Fall season.



## Business & Property Owner Responsibilities

### Holiday Lights:

- We love the holiday spirit but it is time for the sunny season! Don't forget to bring down those holiday lights.

### Tree Irrigation:

- Turn on your irrigation system, this helps keep trees thriving throughout the summer.

### Street Drains:

- Avoid sweeping large piles of debris into the streets. This can block street drains and flood sidewalks.

### Trash Responsibilities:

- Business and property owners have access to their own alley dumpsters. Please avoid throwing large and/or heavy items into street trash cans.
- Trash trails. When throwing large bags of trash into the dumpster, please mop up any liquid trash and/or grease trails left on the sidewalks.

### Animal & Dog Care:

- Encourage customers and community members to clean up after their animals and dogs. This will help keep the streets clear of any fecal matter that can be dragged into businesses.

### Graffiti:
