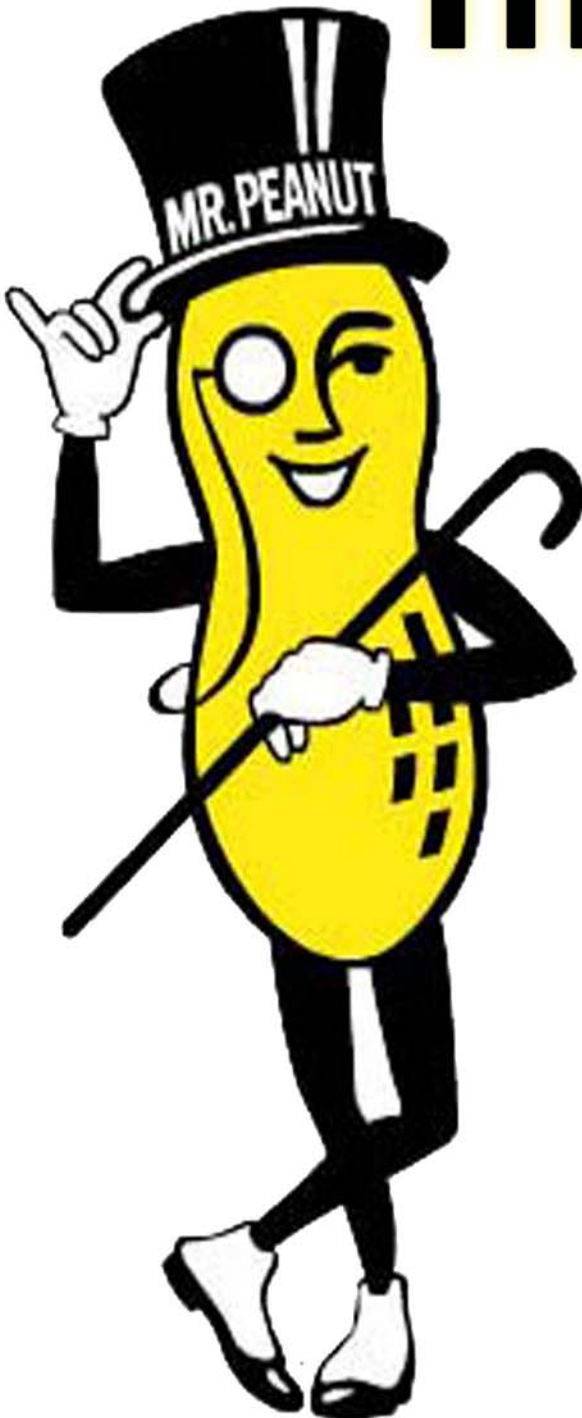


POETRY: CRACKIN' & POPPIN' AT THE PEANUT SHOPPE 2019

There is a permission form that needs to be filled out and signed by a parent/guardian with completed contact info and mailed in. Poems need to be received by the last day of each month. Winners will be contacted by email.

Prizes for the contest: The prizes for the monthly contests are: (1) small box of popcorn and (1) small bag of peanuts and candy. The winning poems will be displayed on the website and inside The Peanut Shoppe for all to see.
