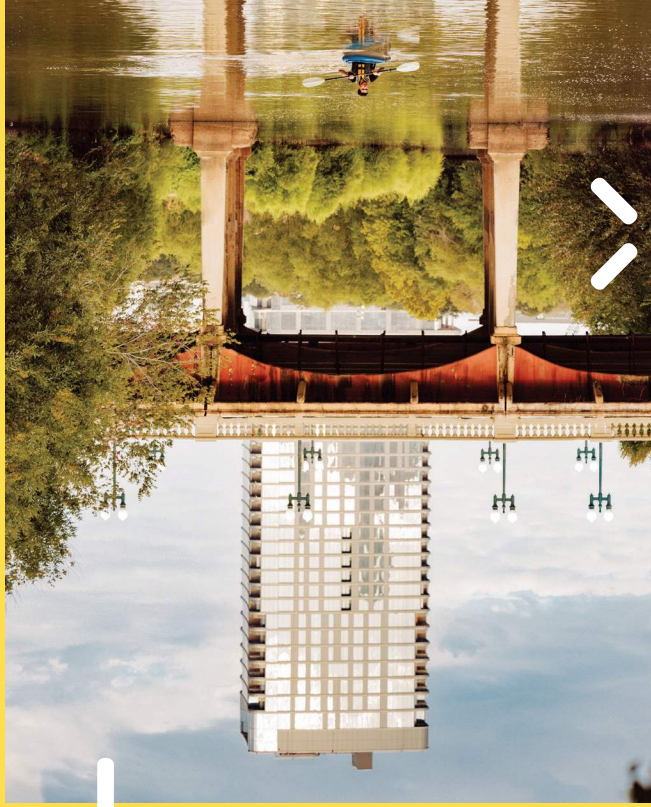

FOOD & DRINK



Stroll, stop and savor the sights and sounds of the George R. Brown (GRB) Convention Center ²⁸, Discovery Green park ³, Hilton Americas-Houston and the Marriott Marquis Events, festivals, and concerts bring the Avenida Houston ³⁶ plaza, park and entertainment area to life, while the convention center and hotels are always abuzz.

AVENIDA HOUSTON

From high art to fun and frolic, nine world-class performing arts organizations live here. The curtain rises on the Alley Theatre ¹⁵, Jones Hall ¹⁹, Wortham Theater Center ²³, the Hobby Center for the Performing Arts ¹⁷, and in the POST Houston ³², the 713 Music Hall ²⁴. Only five U.S. cities boast permanent professional resident companies in each major discipline: ballet, opera, symphony, and theater.

HOUSTON THEATER DISTRICT

Dating back to 1836, Houston's original town center is a favorite of locals and visitors alike. Explore cozy bistros, coffee shops, bars, clubs and more. Perched on downtown's northern edge, the city's most-storied neighborhood bustles with three food halls and inviting green spaces—including Market Square Park ⁸ and Allen's Landing ¹ on Buffalo Bayou ².

Spanning over 300 blocks, Downtown has attractions to enrich any experience you seek. Discover three distinct districts contributing to Downtown's unique flavor. Each is a vibrant neighborhood.

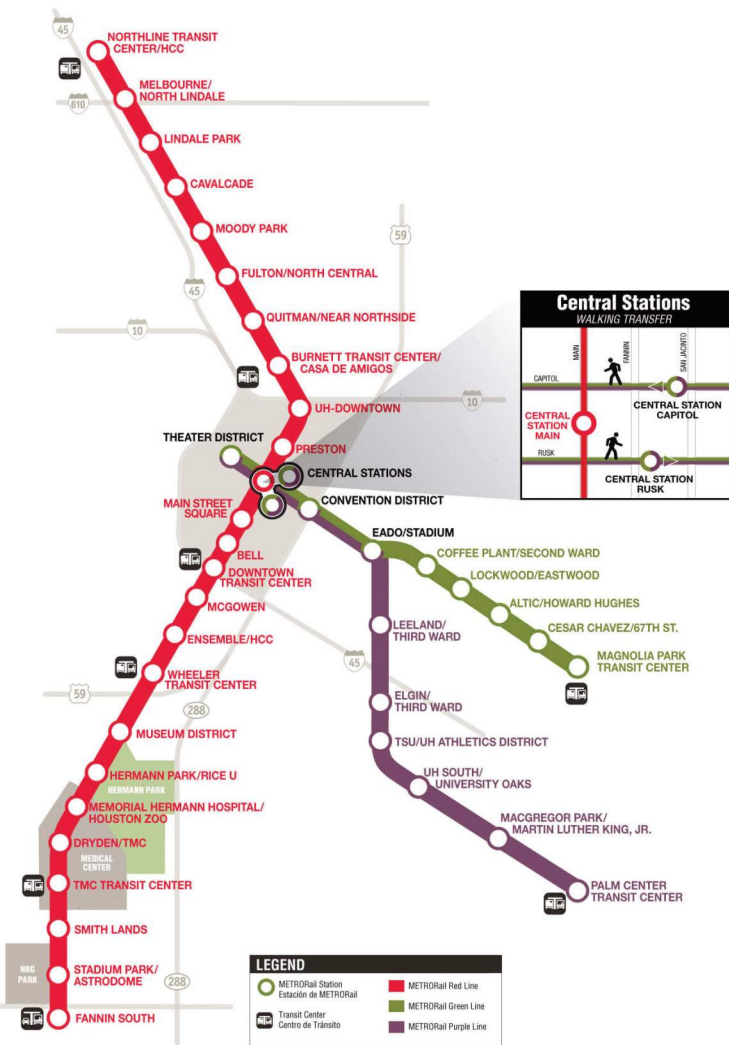
PARKS

There are several services to help you navigate in or around Downtown's expansive neighborhood.

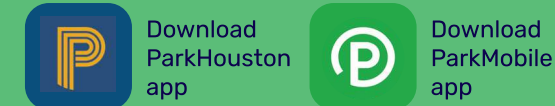
