





Downtown Houston+ is leading the Main Street Promenade initiative, an urban design project and economic development program. This initiative is building on the More Space: Main Street project area.

Last year, the design team hosted multiple public workshops, facilitated collaborative sessions with the City of Houston, and had dozens of conversations with Main Street business owners. This process resulted in the new Main Street Promenade's Basis of Design concept.

Since then, the team has met with the City of Houston, including the Mayor's Office, Public Works, and Houston Fire Department, as well as METRO and CenterPoint. From residents to small businesses, the team has also convened community stakeholders through blockby-block Focus Groups to ensure that the future Main Street Promenade aligns with their vision and needs for the street. This is all leading to a final design plan this fall, so that we can be open for World Cup in 2026!
