#### THE BIG PICTURE

While Downtown boasts amazing parks, stadiums, food halls, theaters and more — each destination acts as its own oasis. The space between lacks a coherent, consistent public realm to connect these places and make our streets vibrant and inviting. The result is that, despite Downtown's many assets, its public realm can feel like less than the sum of its parts.

Downtown Houston+, in partnership with Gehl, Agora Partners, and Outside Voices, is working to create a Public Realm Action Plan to address this. By weaving design, programming, and operations together, the Plan will produce an implementation-based vision for the next generation of Downtown — a roadmap to transform the district into a more livable, delightful, connected, and prosperous place.

#### **Summer 2024**


In the summer, the team will conduct a Public Space Public Life analysis to record how people today move through and experience Downtown.


#### Fall 2024
