New concept from Houston chef Omar Pereney to debut in Spring 2025

HOUSTON, TX - Today, the Houston Downtown Management District board of directors officially selected Houston chef Omar Pereney to operate a new Market Square Park restaurant. Chef Pereney, founder of Culinary Matters and owner of Love Croissants, will oversee the transformation of the sit down restaurant and takeaway counter, Petit Lucie.

A charming French-inspired bakery, café, and bar, Petite Lucie will be nestled in the heart of Market Square Park in Houston's historic district. The revamped space will also feature the addition of a new French bistro-style outdoor bar, a welcoming space for residents, theatergoers, and park visitors to relax and enjoy a refreshing beverage. Renovations will begin this fall, with the restaurant set to reopen in Spring 2025.

Open every day from 7 am to 9 pm, the delightful café will offer a picturesque outdoor seating area, complete with a partially covered awning under mature shade trees.

In the evening, Petite Lucie exudes a romantic ambiance, ideal for a leisurely dinner or a relaxing drink at the bar. Chef Pereney also plans to customize the menu for fan-favorite events, including Movies Under the Stars, Blanket Bingo, and other park programming.

Starting his professional career at 11, he opened his first restaurant, Dalai Restaurant & Lounge, in Caracas at 16. By 18, he was a chef instructor at Le Cordon Bleu in Cancun and later served as Corporate Chef for La Trainera Restaurant Group in Mexico City.

In 2022, Pereney launched Love Croissants, a bakery in Midtown Houston specializing in European-style pastries. His latest venture, Petite Lucie, promises to further showcase his culinary expertise.

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
