

## **Volunteer Positions**

(Please note: All volunteers must be 18 years of age or older)

## POSITIONS BASED AT HARBOR PARK

Line-up and Staging Assistants - Monitor units as they enter the parade staging area (Harbor Park) and wait to be "integrated" into the line-of-march. Estimated Time: 1PM - End of Parade; Volunteers Needed: 20

Band and Bus Assistants - Help with the coordination of bands and band buses from arrival at Harbor Park to parade line-up. Estimated Time: 3PM - End of Parade; Volunteers Needed: 20

Parking Lot Monitors – Monitor all parking lots and areas assigned to volunteers and participants at Harbor Park. Help direct units to their appropriate line-up area upon arrival and disband area at the End of Parade.

Estimated Time: Shift 1-11:30AM-4:30PM; Shift 2-4:00PM- End of Parade; Volunteers Needed: At least 15 per shift

Harbor Park Logistics Assistants - Help set-up the lots at Harbor Park for the arrival of the parade units.

Estimated Time: 9am-1pm; Volunteers Needed: 6

Volunteer and Participant Registration - Check in Volunteers and Parade participants at Harbor Park and direct them to where

they need to go. Estimated Times: Shift 1 - 11AM - 3:30PM; Shift 2 - 3pm - 7:30PM

Volunteers Needed: 1<sup>st</sup> Shift – 4; 2<sup>nd</sup> Shift – 6 (2 people stay until 9pm)

Step-Off/End of Parade Assistants - Assist the parade units as they make their way to step-off and when they return to Harbor Park at the end of the parade. Estimated Time: 5PM- End of Parade Volunteers Needed: 15

Balloon Assistants – Assist balloon company with inflation, handling, route supervision, and deflation. Estimated Time: Shift 1 – 1-6pm; Shift 2 – 6-10pm; Volunteers Needed: At least 2 per shift

## POSITIONS BASED ON THE PARADE ROUTE

Bleacher Monitors - Bleacher monitors will assist with hospitality and sponsor bleachers that are located along the parade route. Monitors assist with decoration, ticket collection and clean-up after the parade.

Estimated Time: 4PM - End of Parade; Volunteers Needed: 25

Parade Route District Assistants - The parade route is divided into specific districts (6 Districts). Help monitor one of those districts before, during and after the parade to make sure everything runs smoothly.

Estimated Time: 2:30PM - End of Parade; Volunteers Needed: 5 per district

**Volunteer Registration** - Check in Volunteers on the parade route and direct them to where they need to go. **Estimated Times: Shift 1 – 11:30am - 4pm; Shift 2 - 3:30pm - End of Parade Volunteers Needed: 5 per shift** 

Logistics Team (Fly Squad) - Work behind the scenes on parade day to make sure all the proper equipment is in place for the big event. If you are interested in the Logistics Team, you will be contacted directly to determine your availability on parade day. Estimated Time: 3pm – 11pm (Fly Squad will have a break during the day); Volunteers Needed: 15

Additional volunteers will be recruited for Pre-Parade Entertainment, Cider Party, and Cool Jack's Café. Those volunteer positions are not listed on the website.
