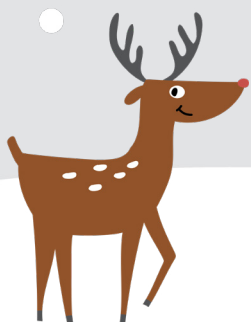

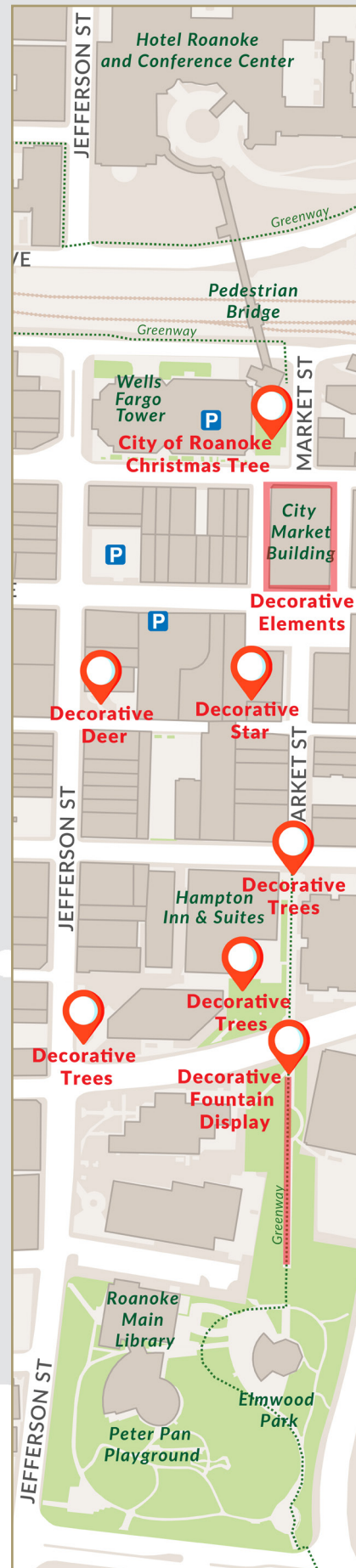
CHRISTMAS TREE & DOWNTOWN ILLUMINATION

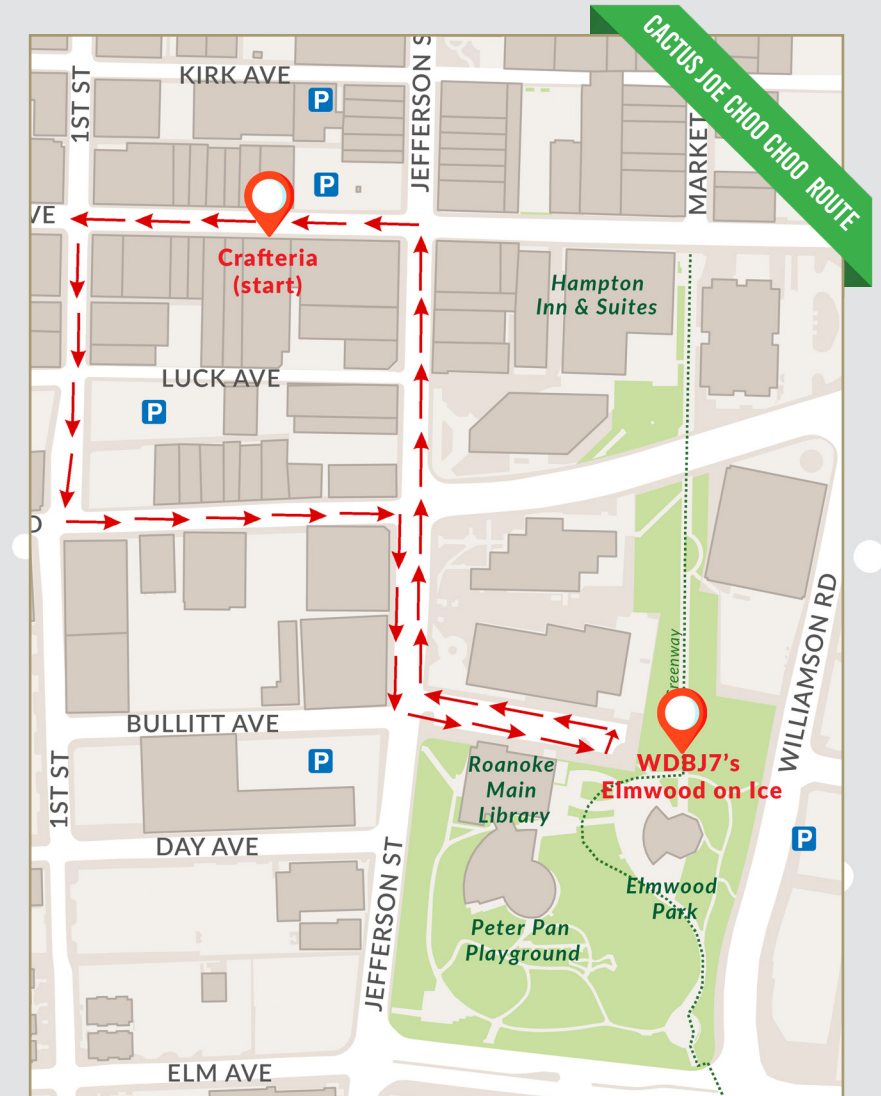

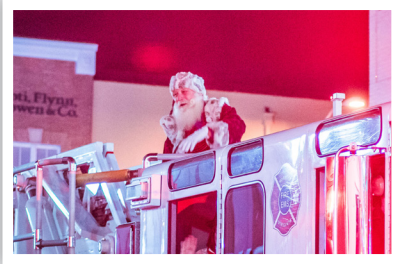

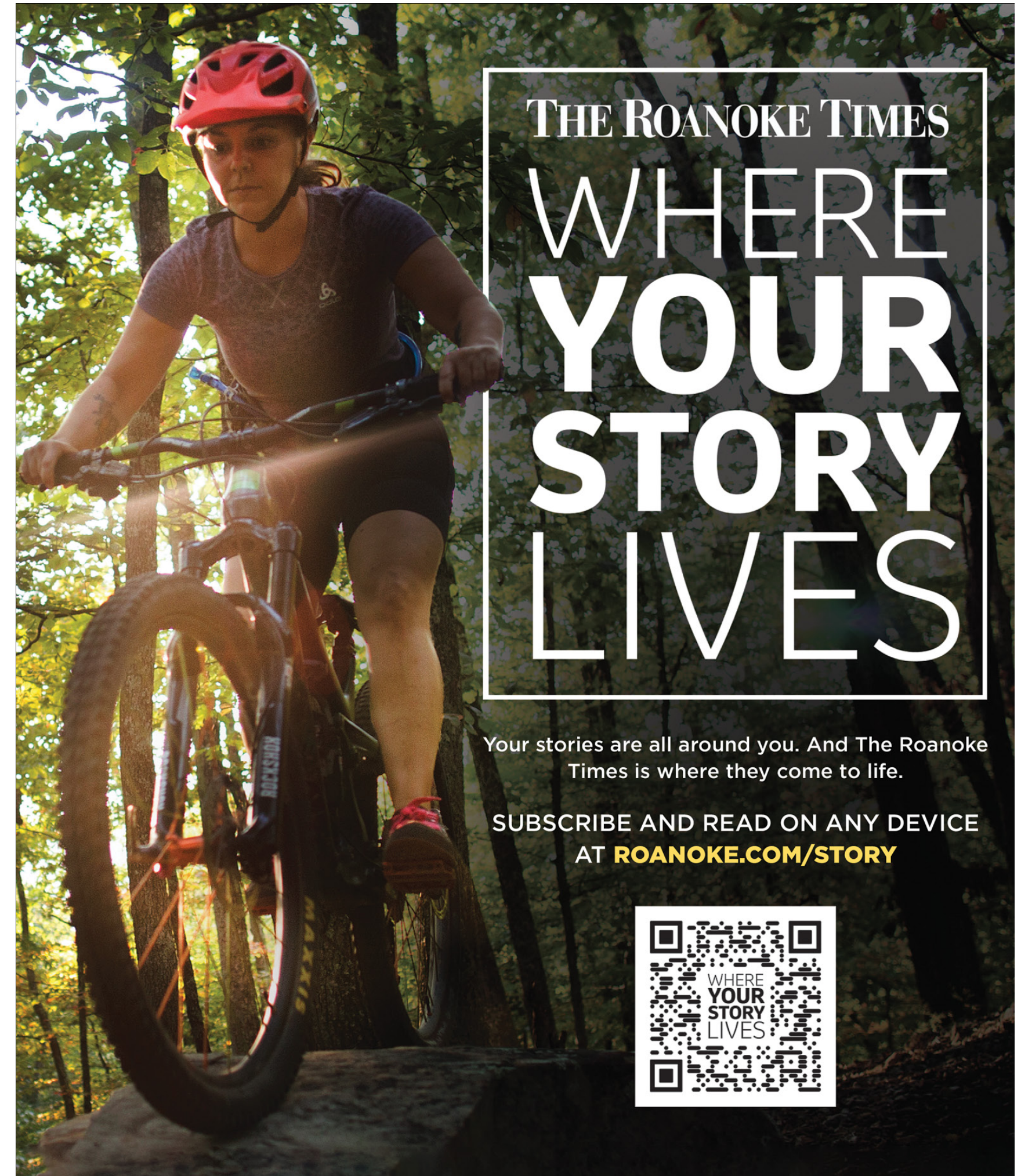
